BE IT ENACTED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WASHBURN STUDENT BAR ASSOCIATION

AN ACT

Section 1. The Washburn Student Bar Association hereby awards and recognizes former WSBA President Britani Potter for her work and dedication to the Washburn Student Bar Association and Washburn University School of Law student body. Said award shall be presented to former WSBA President Potter upon and at her graduation ceremony from Washburn University School of Law.

Section 2. The Washburn Student Bar Association shall allocate an amount not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00) from the WSBA funds for the purchase of said award to be given to former WSBA President Potter.

Section 3. The WSBA President, or their designee chosen from the WSBA Governing Body, shall be approved and empowered to make expenditures, in conformity with Section 2, to accomplish the purposes of this Act.

Section 4. Any WSBA law, policy, procedure, or rule, in whole or in part, in conflict with this Act shall be hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Act shall become effective immediately upon passage.
