An Act to Approve WSBA General Council Vacancy Appointments

Background:

The Washburn Student Bar Association (WSBA) incurs vacancies for the WSBA Governing Body from time to time. WSBA relies on student body members to serve in different positions and capacities on the Governing Body. The WSBA President has the authority and responsibility to appoint student body members to serve when vacancies arise, pursuant to Article V of the WSBA Constitution and Bylaw 108. Appointments made by the WSBA President are subject to the consent of the Governing Body by a simple majority vote. The WSBA President is exercising her appointment authority and requests the consent of the Governing Body.

This bill seeks to approve the nominations made by the WSBA President and fill the vacancies of the following positions: two (2) 2L Representatives, one (1) 3L representative, and the Assistant Secretary-Historian positions.

AN ACT

Section 1. The Washburn Student Bar Association (WSBA) shall hereby approve the following individuals who were nominated by the WSBA President for the open positions for the remainder of their respective position's expected term:

- a) Grace Eagan for the open vacancy of 2L Representative;
- b) Jazmine Peterson for the open vacancy of 2L Representative;
- c) Jackie Hanzok for the open vacancy of 3L Representative;
- d) Ike Summers for the open vacancy of Assistant Secretary-Historian.

Section 2. The term of office for each individual nominated and confirmed, pursuant to Section 1 of this Act, shall hereby commence immediately upon passage of this Act.

Section 3. Any WSBA law, policy, procedure, rule, or regulation, in whole or in part, in conflict with this Act shall be hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Act shall become effective immediately upon passage.
