Background:

The Washburn Student Bar Association (WSBA) is required to adopt a budget every fiscal year. On March 29 and March 30, 2022, the WSBA Budget and Finance Committee, being duly appointed and confirmed by the WSBA Governing Body in accordance with Bylaw 101, met and unanimously approved a budget proposal for the fiscal year 2022-2023. 

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
WASHBURN STUDENT BAR ASSOCIATION

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AN ACT

Section 1. General Provisions.

The Washburn Student Bar Association shall hereby adopt the proposed budget, as amended, and approved by the WSBA Governing Body for its 2022-2023 fiscal year. The 2022-2023 WSBA Budget shall be as described in this Act and as illustrated in the Appendix, attached hereto. The 2022-2023 WSBA Budget shall begin to operate upon the beginning of the new fiscal year, July 1, 2022.

Section 2. Allocations for Student Organizations.

The following amounts are appropriated from the WSBA General Fund to the respective and identified registered student organizations for the 2022-2023 fiscal year:

Section 3. Allocations for the WSBA President’s Discretionary Fund.

The following amount is appropriated from the WSBA General Fund to the WSBA President’s Discretionary Fund for the 2022-2023 fiscal year 1,000

Section 4. Allocations for the WSBA General Operating Fund.

The following amounts are appropriated from the WSBA General Fund to the respective and identified fixed expenses, costs, and events for the 2022-2023 fiscal year:

 - (iii) For Welcome Week: Fall 3,000
 - (iv) For the Welcome Week: Spring 2,000

- (b) Fixed Expenses
 - (i) For annual awards 1,000
 - (ii) For cleaning supplies 100
 - (iii) For flowers, gifts, memorials 500

 - (vi) For office supplies 400
 - (vii) For postage 100
 - (viii) For promotional items 1,500
 - (ix) For software 300
 - (x) For the WSBA website 250
- (c) ABA Conference
 - (i) For the ABA Conference registration fee 200
 - (ii) For lodging 2,618
 - (iii) For travel 1,000
 - (iv) For per diem 1,185
- (d) For student directories 1,400
- (e) For miscellaneous fees 100

Section 5. Any WSBA law, policy, procedure, rule, or regulation, in whole or in part, in conflict with this Act shall be hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Act shall become effective immediately upon passage.
