*Background:*

The Washburn Student Bar Association (WSBA) oversees all student organizations at Washburn University School of Law. WSBA has developed certain bylaws, policies and procedure, and rules and regulations which supervises and guides student organizations. Once a student organization has fulfilled all requirements as provided in WSBA bylaws, policies and procedures, and rules and regulations, that student organization is eligible for initial activation or reactivation to be recognized by and registered with WSBA. Organizations that are registered with and recognized by the WSBA are eligible for the allocated baseline funding by the WSBA.

This bill seeks to activate the Washburn Climate Action Group.



## AN ACT

**Section 1.** The Washburn Student Bar Association shall hereby activate the Washburn Climate Action Group, having properly requested activation and having been certified as meeting all requirements of a WSBA Registered Student Organization.

**Section 2.** As an active and in good standing WSBA Registered Student Organization, the WSBA shall hereby allocate baseline funding for the 2022-2023 academic year.

**Section 3.** Any WSBA law, policy, procedure, rule, or regulation, in whole or in part, in conflict with this Act shall be hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** This Act shall become effective immediately upon passage.
