Background:

The Washburn Student Bar Association (WSBA) supports Bar Revue as an annual social event and any expenses are the responsibility of WSBA. Bar Revue received an unexpectedly high amount of interest, which will cause food and beverage costs to be higher than originally expected. Bar Revue was previously allocated an additional three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500) on April 1, 2022. Since that allocation and after the success of Barrister's Ball, interest in Bar Revue has soared. This bill allocates an additional amount totaling two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500).

An Act to Appropriate Additional Funding for Bar Revue

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WASHBURN STUDENT BAR ASSOCIATION

AN ACT

Section 1. The Washburn Student Bar Association shall hereby allocate an additional two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) from WSBA funds for Bar Revue. This allocation shall be exclusively used for food and beverages, including applicable and expectable fees and taxes. This allocation shall be exclusive and additional to the previous appropriation in Bill No. 2122-56, which allocated three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500).

Section 2. The 2021-2022 Co-Chairs of Bar Revue shall be approved and empowered to make expenditures, in conformity with Section 1, to accomplish the purposes of this Act.

Section 4. Any WSBA law, policy, procedure, rule, or regulation, in whole or in part, in conflict with this Act shall be hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Act shall become effective immediately upon passage.
